

2023 Call for Applications – Junior Professor
BORDEAUX INSTITUTE OF ONCOLOGY (BRIC, INSERM U1312)



The **BORDEAUX INSTITUTE OF ONCOLOGY (BRIC U1312, <https://www.bricbordeaux.com/>)** is seeking to recruit a **Junior Professor** (lecturer/researcher) to reinforce the graduate level biology curriculum offered at the University of Bordeaux and to develop innovative research programs on the biology and treatment of cancer. We seek candidates with expertise in one or more of the following areas: novel 2D/3D models, molecular imaging, and/or multiomic and integrative analyses.

BRIC is a recently established research unit dedicated to cancer research in Bordeaux. Its research program includes genetic and molecular oncogenesis, tumor heterogeneity and microenvironment, and defining the mechanisms of resistance. BRIC comprises 11 teams and is currently located at two sites at the University of Bordeaux (Carreire and Talence campuses), with state-of-the-art core facilities available. To translate basic research findings, BRIC operates in close collaboration with clinical partners at the University Hospital of Bordeaux (CHU) and the Institut Bergonié cancer hospital. The appointed Junior Professor will initially benefit from a reduced teaching workload (64h annually) in order to promote the establishment of a productive research project. S/he will also be provided with a generous package that includes salary for the duration of the contract (commensurate with previous experience, 2eme - 3eme echelon PR2C), appropriate office and lab space, as well as 200 K € start-up funds.

TO APPLY

Eligibility: Candidates must have a PhD or equivalent degree and a strong track record that includes teaching experience and is compatible with application for highly competitive funding.

Two-part application procedure:

(1) Applicants should prepare a single PDF file (single-spaced, 11-point Arial) containing

- Concise CV (1 page) and list of publications
- Contact information for 2-3 references
- Description of past/present research and teaching activities (2 pages)
- Detailed research/teaching proposal including (1) research objectives, rationale, and methodology highlighting the novelty and feasibility of the project, and identification of potential collaborators at BRIC as well as (2) teaching project objectives and operational integration in the education structure (5 pages).
